Public Art Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, January 19, 2022
Zoom (Virtual) Meeting 5:30 p.m.

The West Fargo Public Art Advisory Committee met on Wednesday, January 19, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. Those present were committee members Lauren Kensok, Jodee DeVaney, and Leah Kelm. Also present was City Planner Malachi Petersen. Committee members Jessica Mattson-Fluto and Lisa Dullum were not present.

Public Art Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes
Monday, November 15, 2021
Zoom (Virtual) Meeting 4:30 p.m.

The West Fargo Public Art Advisory Committee met on Monday, November 15, 2021 at 4:30 p.m. Those present were committee members Lisa Dullum, Lauren Kensok, Jodee Devaney, Jessica Matson-Fluto, and Leah Kelm. Also present was City Planner Malachi Petersen. Committee member Ashley Stielow was not present.

Chairperson Dullum called the meeting to order and asked for a motion to approve the order of the agenda. Agenda order was approved. Chairperson Dullum then asked for the minutes from the July 28th meeting to be approved. Due to a Zoom recording error the meeting was not saved and no minutes were taken for that meeting. Committee members chose to then move forward with the rest of the meeting.

Malachi Petersen then gave an overview of a proposed project which would put local art on city-owned traffic light control boxes. The project would be done in coordination with The Arts Partnership and be similar to the art installations done in downtown Fargo a couple of years ago. Petersen outlined the cost of the project at about \$1,500-\$2,000 per installation and proposed a total of four installations located in high pedestrian trafficked areas. After some discussion, Lauren Kensok motion and Jessica Matson-Fluto seconded to direct staff to move forward with the proposed project.

The committee then discussed the potential project further and debated on how to pick the art that would be placed on the traffic light control boxes. After some discussion it was decided that the committee will vote on their top five options via forced ranking. These options will then be presented via an online poll for West Fargo citizens to make the final determination on what are will go where. Committee members also discussed allowing local high school art students have a vote for the art for one of the boxes.

Meeting was then adjourned.
